### TERM 4 LEARNING FOCUS

We will return to the school wide focus on Life Long Learning in term 4. Communities will work together to further grow and develop students competency in aspects of Life Long Learning.

#### The Community Research Questions are as follows:

- Does intentional teaching of self talk deepen perseverance?
- Does intentional teaching of goal setting impact on motivation?
- Does providing the opportunities to experience a disposition deepen their understanding of it?
- Does the specific teaching of the perseverance progression improve the student's ability to persevere?
- Does the use of video enhance student's ability to reflect?
- Does targeted reflection across the community impact the understanding and application of LLL qualities?
- Does the explicit teaching of the risk taking progression enhance independent risk taking?

The end of year school report will include your child's developmental level of competency against each Life Long Learning quality this year. The reason for this inclusion is to show a balanced view of a child's ability in both their knowledge achievement and competency achievement.

Last year we received 100 responses we are very keen to improve on that number.
