



Dear Parents/Caregivers

Your child has expressed an interest in playing Summer Soccer in the Stanmore Bay HBC AFC League. The grades are Year 1/2, 3/4, 5/6 boys, girls or mixed. The teams are 7 aside, with 10 players per team. (mixed teams must have 3 girls on the field at all times). The cost is \$40 per player and games begin on Monday the 31<sup>st</sup> of October until the 12<sup>th</sup> of December, then resuming again on 13<sup>th</sup> Feb to the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012.

**All teams must have an adult manager.**  
**All draws will be emailed weekly to manager.**

Students must wear Boots or Shoes (**no sprigs or studs**) and shin pads (**compulsory**).

## **Red Beach School Summer Soccer Players Code of Behaviour Agreement**

- Play for the 'fun of it' and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your coach approach the official during a break or after the game.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately contacting or provoking an opponent and throwing equipment is not acceptable behaviour in any sport.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
- Be a good sport. Cheer all good play, whether it be by your team or the other.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Be committed to your team. You must show up for all practices and games on time. If you cannot make it you must let your coach or manager know in plenty of time.
