The children understand that this is an art exhibition and that bids are open to anyone. All artworks have a reserve, generally around \$4-\$8. Successful bidders will be contacted on Monday for payment with collection on Tuesday; however you can pay and take the work away with you at 2pm on Saturday if you are there and are the winning bidder. Work that has not been bid on will be donated to local charities.

Friday 30th September- Doors open at 6pm. Gold coin donation entry + programmes \$2.


